The company RS Law & Society Consulting B.V., located in Hoofddorp, the Netherlands, European Union, registered under chamber of commerce number: 34281084 (hereinafter referred to as: RS Law), takes your privacy seriously and treats all personal information we process about you with great care. RS Law does so by acting in accordance with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation and various other (national) legislation regarding privacy protection.

#### **1. Who are we?**

RS Law is specialized in providing in-depth legal advice on the following subjects: EMU law, banking regulation legislation and competition law. We do so by offering consultancy services as well as a *emeritus* professor of the law of the Economic and Monetary Union (EMU) at the University of Amsterdam.

#### **2. What information does RS Law collect and process?**

On our website, we do not collect personal data, unless you provide your personal data through the contact form. In those cases, we only collect general contact information, such as your name, email address and/or phone number. We only collect the information we need to adequately respond to your inquiry.

### **3. For what purposes will RS Law use information about you?**

RS Law may use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To contact you regarding an enquiry made by you; and
- Anonymized data for statistical and quality assurance measures.

RS Law will not provide your personal data to third parties for commercial or any other purposes. RS Law will only provide your personal data to third parties if it is obliged to do so on account of European, national or international law, if RS Law considers it necessary to do so in defense of its own rights or if you have provided consent to do so.

### **4. How does RS Law protect your personal information and where is the data stored?**

RS Law takes appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your (personal) information against loss or any form of unlawful use. Your personal data is stored in the Netherlands and shall not be transferred outside the European Union.

### **5. Retention periods**

We will retain collected personal data for as long as is necessary to provide you with the requested service unless a longer retention period is required by law.

### **6. Viewing, changing, and deleting your data**

Once you have submitted such a request, RS Law will delete all your personal data it has in its possession, unless it is legally not permitted to delete it.
